



# LEVEL III INSPECTOR EXAM CHECKLIST

## Certification Exam Process Requirements:

- Be a Member in good standing (Annual dues are up to date)
- Exam Application Submitted
  - Completed application
  - Verification letter
  - Proof of eye examination
  - Other required documentation if necessary, as noted in the copied section of the Certification Program Rules regarding Limited Specialty requirements posted below
- Examination Fee Paid – If an invoice is requested, results will not be released until all fees are received by NAARSO

## REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION AND CERTIFICATION RENEWALS FOR INSPECTION OF AMUSEMENT RIDES AND DEVICES

### LEVEL III (SENIOR) INSPECTOR CERTIFICATION

All Level III (Senior) Inspector Certification holders are required to demonstrate a commitment to the amusement industry, diverse knowledge of codes and standards, as well as a high level of self-initiative.

Level III (Senior) Inspector Certificate holders shall support NAARSO to the extent of their collective knowledge and use their energy and substance in the areas of training and instruction to advance the NAARSO philosophy of "Safety Through Communication." Each Level III inspector shall instruct a pre-approved program at a NAARSO approved training conference once every two years or equivalent.

Applicants for Level III (Senior) Inspector certification shall satisfy the requirements of this section.

The senior level is obtained through a combination of experience, testing and training beyond the Level II (Advanced) Inspector Certification. All of the following requirements shall be met:

- Must possess a current NAARSO Level II (Advanced) Inspector certification for at least 2 years.
- Must be a current NAARSO member in good standing.
- Shall have verifiable documentation of ten (10) years of experience in the amusement ride inspection field.
- Must have worked in the amusement ride and device inspection field a minimum of three (3) years out of the past five (5) years primarily employed in the amusement ride field. This shall be determined by the Certification Board.
- Shall be currently employed in the amusement ride field.
- Shall possess a high level of knowledge, education, and experience related to the amusement ride and device industry.
- Have a minimum of eighty (80) hours of accredited amusement ride safety training within the past four (4) years with verifiable documentation of NAARSO approved training.
- If an applicant has not previously instructed at a NAARSO approved school, or served as an officer or committee member within the NAARSO organization, applicants must submit an original idea with outline for a one (1) hour industry related safety training class and be reviewed/approved by the Board.
- Applicants must have two (2) current Level III Inspector certification holders review the application and supporting documentation and sign as sponsors for the applicant prior to presenting the packet to the Board for consideration.
- Application shall show evidence of an eye exam within the previous 12 months. Eye exam requirements shall be in accordance with ASTM F2974 visually acuity.
