



LEVEL II OPERATIONS EXAM CHECKLIST

Certification Exam Process Requirements:

- Exam Application Submitted
 - Completed application
 - Verification letter
 - Proof of 32 hours NAARSO approved continuing education with 16 of said hours must be NAARSO approved Advanced Operations classes
 - Proof of eye examination
 - Other required documentation if necessary, as noted in the Certification Handbook
- Examination Fee Paid – If an invoice is requested, results will not be released until all fees are received by NAARSO

LEVELII (ADVANCED) OPERATIONS CERTIFICATION

Applicants for Level II (Advanced) Operations Certification shall satisfy the requirements of this section. This level is obtained through a combination of testing and experience.

In order to take the NAARSO Operations Certification Examination, the applicant shall meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must possess a current NAARSO Level I (Basic) Operations Certification.
- Applicants must possess verifiable documentation of five (5) years of employment and current employment in the operation of amusement rides and devices.
- Applicants must possess the ability to read, write, and comprehend the English language.
- All applicants must pass a written examination.
- All applicants must provide proof of successful completion of at least 3.2 continuing education units (CEUs) or 32 hours of NAARSO approved formal training within the past twenty-four (24) months prior to applying to take the examination. At least 16 of these 32 hours must be NAARSO approved Operation Classes.

Application shall show evidence of an eye exam within the previous twelve (12) months. Eye exam requirements shall be in accordance with ASTM F2974 visually acuity.
